Presenter Information

Adolfo Tarango, Head, CJK, Serials & Shared Cataloging Division, UC San Diego Libraries. Adolfo received his MLIS from the University of Michigan, where he started his professional career working as a rare books cataloger at the William L. Clemens Library. Three years later, he moved to become the serials cataloger at the University of Nevada, Reno. While at Reno, he co-authored the book *Developing and Managing Electronic Journal Collections* contributing several chapters on access and cataloging of e-journals. Adolfo is actively involved in the Program for Cooperative Cataloging, currently serving as Chair of the PCC Standing Committee on Automation, and in CONSER, having served on a variety of CONSER task groups.

Rebecca Culbertson, Electronic Resources Cataloging Librarian, UC San Diego Libraries. Becky currently is a member of the Shared Cataloging Program at the University of California, San Diego and catalogs all resources of an electronic remote nature. Becky received her MALS from the University of Michigan, where she started her professional career working as descriptive cataloger at the General Library. Three years later, she moved to become a cataloger at the University of Georgia, Athens. Becky is actively involved in the Program for Cooperative Cataloging, currently serving as Chair of the PCC Standing Committee on Standards, and in CONSER, having served on a variety of PCC task groups. Most recently she served as co-chair of the PCC Provider-Neutral E-Monograph Record Task Force.



Michael Colby, Assistant Head, Cataloging and Metadata Services Department, Shields Library, UC Davis. Michael has nearly 30 years experience in libraries. This includes over 25 years as a professional cataloger in academic and public libraries at the University of California--Davis, San Francisco Public Library, and Bowling Green State University. He has also done reference, bibliographic instruction and collection development. He earned the MLIS at the University of California, Berkeley and an MA at San Francisco State University. He has been active in the American Library Association, the Music Library Association and the International Association of Music Libraries. In his spare time he plays music and worries about the future of access to information.
